COVID-19 Compensation Documentation for Transitioned Physicians

PYA's <u>Stark Law Blanket Waiver Documentation Checklist</u> may provide sufficient record for maintaining appropriate physician resources for coverage and care provision during the COVID-19 pandemic. However, depending on a healthcare organization's specific facts and circumstances, other documentation may be required. As such, PYA has developed the following form, which may serve to help support an appropriate record regarding the provision of COVID-19-related physician services.
